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Annual Report 2024-2025

It is with great pleasure we present the Annual Report for the Academic year 2024-2025. The year witnessed notable achievements in academics, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. Our students, teachers and staff worked with dedication and enthusiasm, creating a vibrant learning environment while upholding the values of leadership, responsibility and holistic development.

1. Key highlights of the year:-

A) Major Programs and events conducted by the school

- Handwriting Competition, Recitation Competition, Elocution Competition, Debate Competition (Class-X), Music and Dance Competition were conducted as a part of extracurricular activity for the holistic development of students.
- Apart from various cultural events conducted as per the school calendar Arts Exhibition was organized in the school premises on the day of Saraswati Puja.
- On 12th Jan, 2024, School celebrated Swami Vivekananda's Birth Anniversary with due reverence and pride. Rally was taken out by the students under the guidance of the teachers to make people aware of Swamiji's teachings.

b) Competitions and Events conducted by CBSE.

- Students participated in 'Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign' 2024 conducted by CBSE. A Cleanliness drive in the school was organized. An Essay competition on the importance of Waste management and Elimination of single use plastic was conducted as well.
- 'Project Veer Gatha'4.0 was conducted by school under the aegis of CBSE on 30/09/2024. Students participated enthusiastically from class 3 to 10 and were awarded online certificates.
- 'All India Swachh Bharat Art Competition' organized by National Education and Human Resource Development organized was held on 28th August, 2024 at school premises. Topics included Colouring, Drawing, and Painting Competition (VIII-X). Essay writing Competition (I-VII).
- In collaboration with My Gov, the NDMA conducted an awareness campaign in the form of Poster Making and Essay writing contests on My Gov platform on the topic

- Students of class VI to X participated in story writing competition conducted by CBSE under CBSE 'Building Authors' programme and learn to read and read to Learn.
- Vigilance Awareness week was observed from 28/10/2024 to 03/11/24 with the theme 'Culture of Integrality for Nation's Prosperity' by the students of class X. a pledge was taken by teachers and students on the occasion and students were sensitized about the ill-effects of corruption through activities like lectures, essay writing competition and poster making competition as per the guidelines of CBSE.
- In order to foster environmental stewardship among students as per the CBSE guidelines, to promote tree plantation and water conservation, an initiative aligned with the " Ek Ped Maa ke Naam" (Plant for Mother) campaign, school teachers attended seminars and tree plantation activity by students was held in school.

For class VIII, students met grade-level expectations in Maths, Science and English.
